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## 1) STARTING FEE ONLINE/ ON SITE

► DRAGON SUP TEAM

1 day = 400 Kč (100 Kč per team member)

- each member who starts in some race of the Czech SUP Cup Series (sprint, technical race, long distance) has his starting fee included. Member who doesn't start in any of the discipline has to pay 100 Kč and pick up a race Jersey at the registration desk.

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## 2) KATEGORIE A BOARD:

Category:

- DRAGON SUP CREW: 4 members, min 1 man and 1 woman (could be substituted with a KID),

- DRAGON SUP BOARD: length max. 22' x 34", 4 riders in a row

- DISCIPLINE: SPRINT race, each team has its own turn buoy

- lending dragon board for the race guaranteed, included in a starting fee. Dragon boards will be at rider's disposal for the training since Friday 21st August – after the registration.

### 3) RULES DRAGON SUP

Valid rules [www.dragonworldseries.com](http://www.dragonworldseries.com)

- 1) A 'team' comprises 4 people on the board.
- 2) A team must remain the same for the duration of one race.
- 3) Start/ Finish line on water: All team members must be on the board and standing when crossing the start and finish line.  
Start/ Finish line on the beach: All team members start with a run from the beach with board and paddle in their hand. Finish line on the beach: Counts the first team member running across the finish line with the paddle in his hand.
- 4) A maximum of three people are allowed to kneel at each buoy/turn.
- 5) While turning buoy, kneeling participants must stand after a maximum of 10 strokes (taken by the individual).
